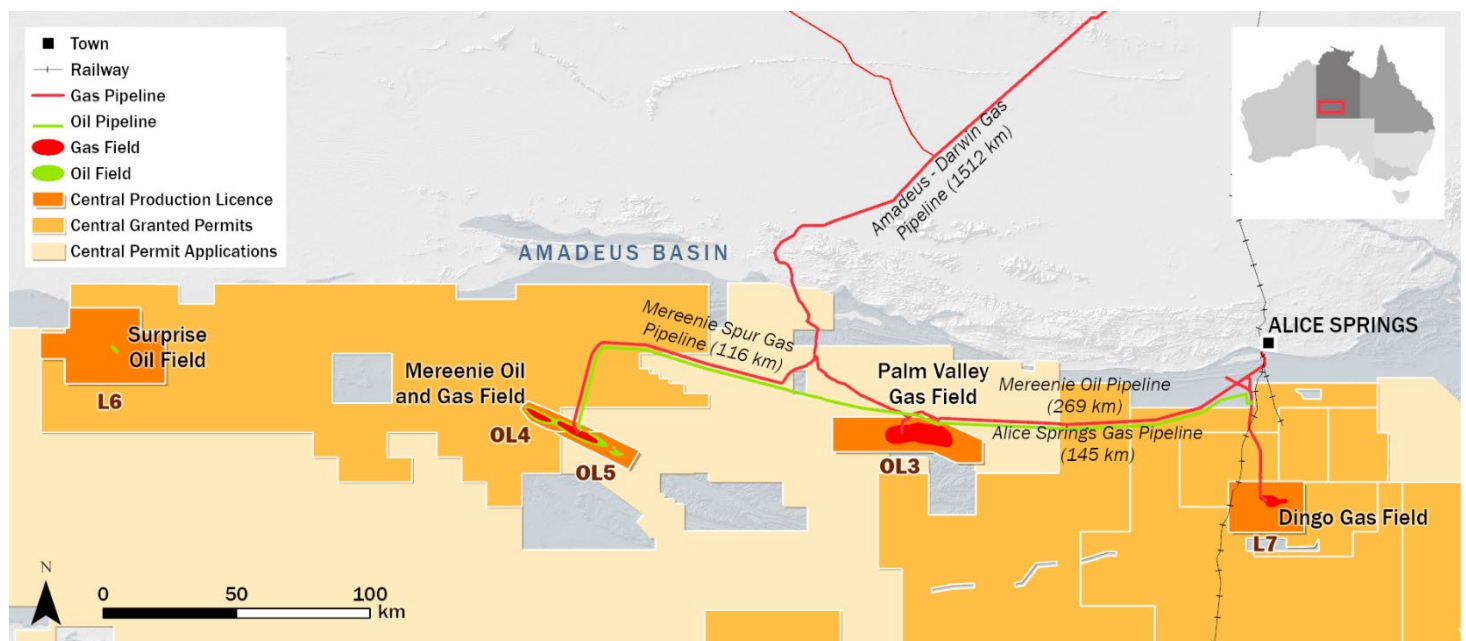


# Central Petroleum Limited Producing Assets

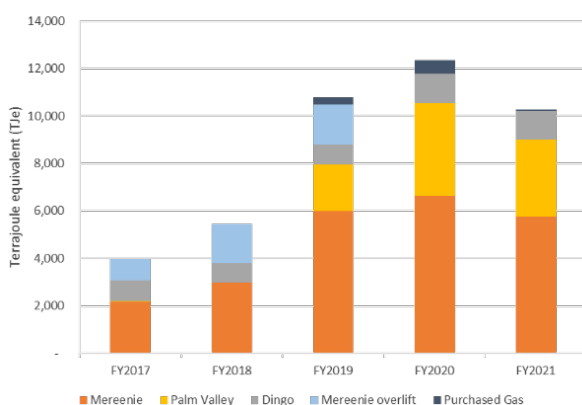
Central operates the largest onshore producing gas fields in the Northern Territory, supplying oil and gas from its Mereenie, Palm Valley and Dingo fields to customers in the Northern Territory and the wider Australian east coast market.

Oil and gas was first discovered in these areas in the 1960s and gas supply was limited to customers in the Northern Territory until the Northern Gas Pipeline (NGP) was opened in January 2019. The Mereenie and Palm Valley fields were expanded to take advantage of the additional market access and are now connected via the NGP to customers in the eastern states.



Current 2P reserves of 74 PJe (net to CTP<sup>1</sup>) are backed by long-term gas sales agreements with blue-chip customers, including: AGL, Energy Developments Limited and Power and Water Corporation.
