

Gas Day Harmonisation

Central Petroleum Transition Plan

Central Petroleum outlines its compliance procedure with the Gas Day Harmonisation (GDH) Transition Plan as Operator of the Mereenie, Palm Valley and Dingo Gas Plants. The plan aligns the reporting of Central Petroleum Production Facilities with the East Coast Gas Market start time of 6:00am Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) from 1 October 2019.

Obligations

As a production facility Operator, Central Petroleum is required to implement the standard gas day from 1 Oct 2019. The standard nomination timetables apply to certain transport facilities (including the AGP) and gas Bulletin Board reporting.

Connections / Metering

Central Petroleum gas facilities are interconnected with the Amadeus Gas Pipeline (AGP) which is affected by the GDH. The connections are operated by APA Group and the transition plan is outlined in APA Group's *Gas Day Harmonisation transmission transition plan published on 30 June 2019*.

Central Petroleum has identified that the key metering systems at Mereenie and Palm Valley which require adjusted reporting are both operated by APA Group.

The Dingo facility connects to the Owen Springs Power Station via a custody transfer metering station located at the Brewer Estate City Gate Station. The flow computer will be reconfigured on 30 September 2019 to reflect the earlier rollover time of 06:00am AEST.

Facilities

The Mereenie facility connects to the AGP via the APA operated Mereenie Inlet Station. Future binding gas supply contracts that may be entered into by Central Petroleum will reflect the new gas day start time. Nomination times will not require amendment to meet the revised standard gas day.

The Palm Valley facility connects to the AGP via the APA operated Palm Valley Inlet Station. Future binding gas supply contracts that may be entered into by Central Petroleum will reflect the new gas day start time. Nomination times will not require amendment to meet the revised standard gas day.

Short Gas Day Nomination – 30 September 2019

Central Petroleum will ensure it operates consistently with the AEMO guiding principles. Nominations for the short gas day of 30 September 2019 will reflect the short gas day duration of 21.5 hours. The 2.5 hours from 5.30am to 8am will be included in the next gas day (1 October 2019).
